The Sunday tea dance will have it's usual wonderful spread of cakes - if you're able to contribute to this we'd be grateful - the more the merrier!

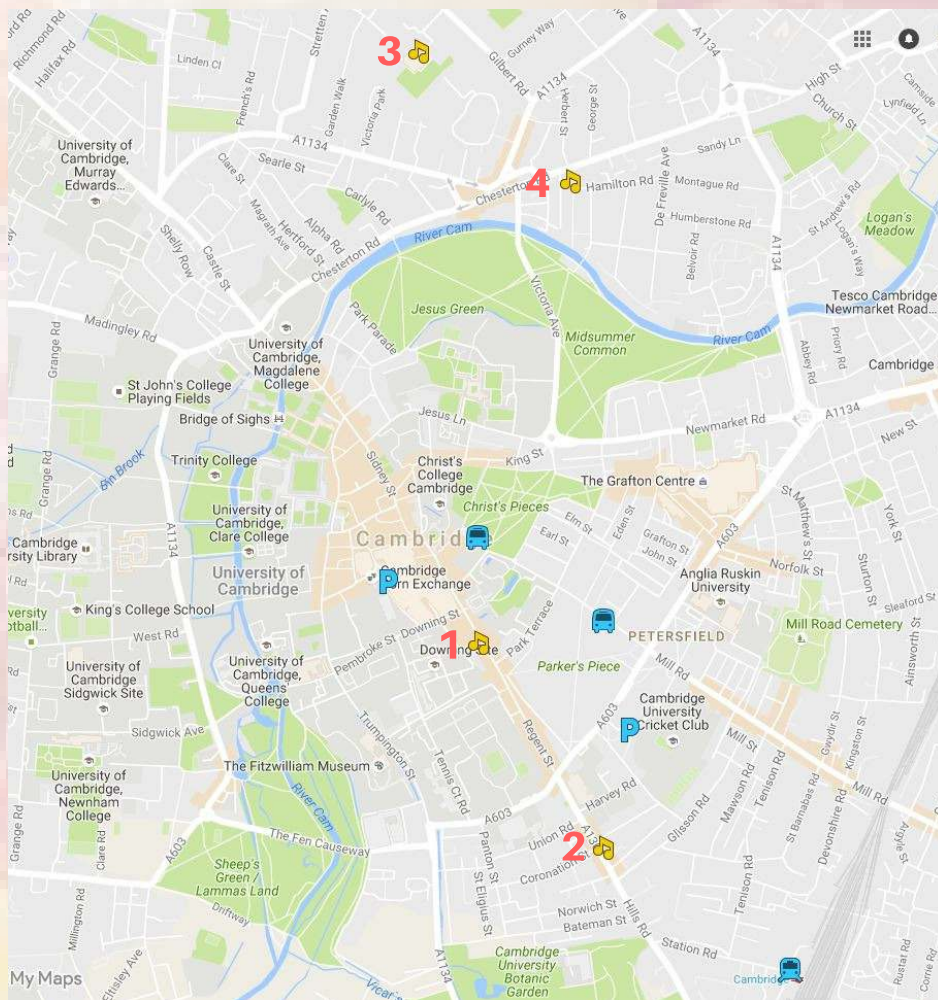
Getting around

Taxis, buses and car parks:

Panther taxis (01223 715715) and A1 CabCo (01223 313131)

Stagecoach Citi buses 1, 3 and 7 will get you to the centre of town from the train station, or it's about a 30 minute walk.

Car parking is limited at our Friday and Saturday venues. You'll find on-street parking across town, or you can use the Grand Arcade (~5 min walk from St Andrew's, ~10 mins from St Paul's) or Queen Anne Terrace (~10 mins from St Andrew's, ~5 mins from St Paul's) which are both open 24 hours. Chesterton Community College on the Sunday has plenty of parking available and is just a 10 minute cab ride or half hour walk from the middle of town.
